GCAB EXPECTATIONS

1. Attend 5 of the 6 scheduled full associate board meetings a year (excludes any committee or sub-committee meetings)
2. Achieve a "Give/Get" of at least \$150 (excludes in-kind donations) in a calendar year
3. Serve on one committee for the duration of membership term (members may change committees during term)
4. Volunteer for at least one AB-sponsored event within a calendar year
5. Terms are 2 years, though members can serve up to 3 terms for a total of a six-year commitment
